COURSE TITLE: Confined Spaces Awareness and Risk Assessment

WHO SHOULD ATTEND:

This course is aimed at Managers and Supervisors and all those with responsibility for controlling work in Confined Spaces and/or carrying out risk assessments prior to permitting entry into Confined Spaces. Delegates should already be capable of carrying out general risk assessments. This course is not suitable for those who have a need to enter/work in a Confined Space.

AIMS:

This classroom based course will provide awareness of the legal responsibilities placed on Employers in relation to Confined Spaces and on those that they designate as controlling that responsibility on their behalf. On successful completion of the course delegates will be aware of the requirements of the Confined Spaces Regulations 1997, the need for Risk Assessments, be capable of carrying out a risk assessment and subsequently developing Safe Systems of Work for entry into a Confined Space.

COURSE CONTENT:

- Confined Spaces Regulations 1997
- Who is competent to carry out this risk assessment?
- Avoiding the need for entry
- Risk Assessments
- Safe systems of work including permits to work
- Arrangements for Emergencies
- Equipment required to enter a Confined Space
- Personal Protective Equipment and Hygiene
- Maintenance of Equipment
- Ventilation and the avoidance of unsafe atmospheres
- Manpower including training requirements
- Communication and entry procedures
