**COURSE TITLE:** IOSH – Working Safely

**WHO SHOULD ATTEND:**

Carry out work activities without endangering themselves or other. Report relevant accidents and incidents and monitor their own activities and assist managers in active monitoring.

- Introduction to working safely
- Definition of working safely

- Assessments of risks associated with hazards
- Using appropriate workplace precautions for specific tasks
- Identifying common hazards, ie. fire, electricity, work traffic, physical and verbal abuse, working environment, slips, trips and falls, manual handling, noise, chemicals etc
- Improving safety performance. ie. safe systems of work, permits to work, protective equipment, safety signs, emergency procedures, accident/incident reporting, health checks, contract work, inspections etc.
- Protecting the environment. ie. waste control, pollution control, contributing to reducing environmental impacts
